#### Bishop Creek Water Association Meeting Summary April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2016

## I. Opening and Introductions

The BCWA meeting was opened at 7:06 p.m. Trustees in attendance included: Gene Coufal, Merry Armstrong, Henry Means, Rock Baker and Greg Loveland. Watermaster Chas Coufal was in attendance as well.

#### II. March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 Meeting Summary

The summary of the March 1st, 2016 Monthly Meeting was reviewed and approved.

## **III.** Financial Reports

The Financial Report for March 2016 was not in the packet. Gene read the report results from another copy. Approval was delayed until the May meeting.

## IV. Snowpack Report

Greg gave a report on the current snowpack and precipitation conditions.

## V. Bishop Creek Flow and Storage Report

Burt Almond reported that the estimated snowpack for the Bishop Creek drainage is 72% of normal with a runoff estimated at 39,000 AF. Chandler decree flows will require 33,000 AF and in order to maintain a winter flow from Oct-Mar of approximately 50 CFS, SCE will need 9,000 AF in storage come Oct. 1. Burt also reported that the peak runoff should be expected around July 1<sup>st</sup>.

Gene reported that he had discussed Chandler Decree flows with Dan Golden of SCE and at this time SCE expects to follow the Chandler Decree flow schedule. SCE is aware of the need to maintain enough flow during the winter for stockwater and to keep ditches wet. SCE and LADWP will meet next week to discuss operations for the upcoming runoff year. The discussion at the meeting revolved around if a letter should be written to Southern California Edison requesting that the flow schedule of the Chandler Decree not be followed. The Board will monitor discussion between SCE and LADWP and recommend a course of action if needed.

#### VI. Water and Arbitration Committee Report

No formal meeting.

Culvert replacement has been completed by homeowner on Audrey Lane and flow has been restored to ditch.

Manor area is experiencing fluctuating flows is certain areas due to unauthorized adjustments.

Problem on Carol Lane with water appearing on roadway on both sides of the street.

The ditches in areas where there is ground saturation will be given flow to reach as many if not all members possible while not overwhelming the perched aquafer. It is hoped that this will allow the ditches and ponds to seal over time.

## VII. Watermaster Report

Chas reported that he has been receiving an increased number of calls and requests for irrigation water. He also reported that he has been pursuing notorious problem areas and has been making more house calls. He reminded the membership to maintain the ditches on their property to keep the system running efficiently.

## VIII. Old Business

- a) Bylaws Revision
  - The April 2016 Version of the Bylaws was passed out to the membership and is now available on the Association's website.
- b) Finance Committee Report
  - Gene Coufal and Craig Patton met with an attorney, Peter Tracy, to discuss collection of unpaid dues. Financial committee will meet to discuss a recommendation.
  - There was a motion to approve the funds (\$1,200) to hire an attorney to pursue the collection of past dues. The motion was approved by a vote of the membership with no dissenting votes.
- c) Reinhackle Ditch Flow Issue
  - The issue is being discussed among the affected parties. Progress is being made but additional discussions will need to take place.
- d) Ditch Repair
  - i. Gene presented plans for diversion structure repair/replacement. There were 5 diversions that were discussed and pictures of the existing conditions were presented along with the price estimates for the proposed diversions structures. (attached)
    - There was a motion to approve the repair work. The membership approved the motion by way of vote to repair the diversion structures at locations 1,2,3,4 and 5 with no dissenting votes.
- e) Approval to reconstruct 2 diversion boxes on McLaren Ditch at Ranch Road.
  - This agenda items was discussed and acted upon with the Item "d" above.

- f) Parkwest Water
  - Rock is working on getting water to Parkwest and this should be done in the next two weeks.
- g) Insurance Update
  - Rock has additional questions and will contact the company within the next ten days. The coverage will stay the same as the current policy but the price will be decreased. The company is asking for a three year commitment but will allow for cancelation with a one year notification. The board unanimously approved moving forward with the new policy if Rock's questions are answered satisfactorily.
- h) Plans for diversion structure repair / replacement
  - Plans are in the works.

#### IX. New Business

- a) Appointment of Water and Arbitration Committee
  - Melinda Scott and Dennis Rottner are being considered. Rock will be contacting a prospective third candidate and there was a request to have a DWP representative on the board as well.
- b) Appointment of Finance Committee
  - Sandy Fuhrer, Susan Kunze, Craig Patton and Greg Loveland were appointed to the committee and Henry Means will act as Chairman.
- c) Approval to reconstruct diversion box on Orcier Ditch
  - This was covered in Item VIII.d.
- d) Other (Members in Good Standing)
  - No other new business

#### X. Next Meeting

The next meeting of the Bishop Creek Water Association will be on Tuesday, May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at 7 pm at the high school library.






