Bishop Creek Water Association Annual Meeting Summary January 30, 2017

I. Opening and Introductions

The BCWA meeting was opened at 7:04 p.m. Trustees in attendance included: Gene Coufal, Merry Armstrong, Rock Baker, Greg Loveland, and Henry Means. Watermaster, Chas Coufal was in attendance as well.

II. Approval of the January 3, 2017 Meeting Summary

The summary of the January 3, 2017 monthly meeting was reviewed and approved as written.

III. Annual Report

President Gene Coufal reported on the accomplishments of the Bishop Creek Water Association (BCWA) during 2016. In addition to the day to day operations, BCWA accomplishments included:

- a) Progress was made on trying to recoup past due assessments. It is expected that the BCWA will be prepared to go to small claims court early 2017 (see below);
- b) An assessment of BCWA facilities was completed and a budget developed to make repairs (see below);
- c) An agreement to return the Reinhackle Ditch to historic operation has been reached. Repair of ditch structure is anticipated early 2017;
- d) Meeting agendas and summaries are now being posted on the BCWA website;
- e) BCWA worked closely with SCE and LADWP to keep ditches wet.
- f) The most recent version of the BCWA Articles and Bylaws has been posted to the BCWA website (amended on May 20, 2017);
- g) Worked with Inyo County and California DWR on the high groundwater issue;
- h) Insurance plan changed, saving approximately \$1500 per year.
- i) Major capital repairs consisted of two culverts in McLaren area, Vista Ditch repaired, four headwalls rebuilt in McLaren area, and two structures on the Ocier Ditch.

IV. Report on Diversion Box Repair/Replacement Work Plan

An updated structure repair and rebuild plan (capital work) was presented, looking at a three-year approach (see attached). The location list was reprioritized based on all feeder ditch repairs being placed in the top prioritized group. Gene explained the plan and approach. A question was raised to clarify work on Carol Lane. Gene noted that the projects will need to be further refined, and will be presented to membership prior to beginning site construct. The presented Repair/Replacement Plan is an estimate.

V. 2016 Financial Report

Henry presented the 2016 Financial Report (see attached).

Budgeted: \$56,787 Actual: \$56,605

VI. 2017 Budget

Gene presented the 2017 budget to membership (see attached). He presented the four budget options evaluated by the Finance Committee (see attached):

- A) No assessment change (no action to implement capital work);
- B) Absorb capital work in existing assessment;
- C) Maintain current assessment and implement a new special assessment to cover capital work;
- D) New assessment to absorb capital work and build Operating and Maintenance Reserve.

Gene reported that the Financial Committee recommended Option D (i.e., \$40 for individual parcels and \$2.90/acre for large parcel owners). It was noted that each of the budget options included a \$60/month take home pay increase for the Watermaster. Motion was moved to approve Option D. A motion to approve Option D was made, seconded and approved unanimously with one dissenting vote.

VII. Bishop Creek Precipitation and Flow Report

Greg Loveland reported on the Bishop Creek precipitation (see attached precipitation chart).

VIII. Old Business

- a) Collection of Past Due Assessments: Gene Coufal discussed the direction of Finance committee and the Board regarding past dues collection. Gene was waiting for 2017 budget approval to continue seeking legal direction from Peter Tracey regarding preparation for small claims court. Gene will proceed and report back to the Board and membership.
- b) Reinhackle Ditch: work is in progress to replace 4 diversion structures in the ditch. Installation should be completed by April 1, 2017
- c) High Groundwater Issue: The Department of Water Resources report can be found on the BCWA and Inyo County Water Department websites. Comment from a member that management of Bishop Creek is necessary to insure we don't experience high groundwater in West Bishop area. Another comment was made by Ken Poole on Highland Drive regarding sealing of ponds, he wishes to test the sealing but the water is inconsistent. Watermaster, Chas Coufal explained that the current freeze and thaw, weather conditions is hampering getting water down Highland Drive.

IX. New Business

Steve Stevens, head of the Nominating Committee, recognized work of BCWA Board member Rock Baker who did not want to be considered for another term. Gene Coufal was willing to continue on the Board if re-elected. Steve recommended that Don Kunze and Gene Coufal be considered for the two open Board vacancies.

X. Election of Trustees (Greg Loveland, Rock Baker, and Gene Coufal's terms are expired)

A motion was made to elect Gene Coufal and Don Kunze to the two vacant Board position for the two year term of 2017-2018. The membership voted by a show of hands to elect both, Gene Coufal and Don Kunze. This passed by a unanimous vote. Greg Loveland as the LADWP's representative will continue in his position on the Board.

XI. Next Meeting

Because of schedule conflicts, a proposal to move the monthly BCWA meeting to the second Tuesday of the month was approved.

The next meeting of the Bishop Creek Water Association will be on Tuesday, March 14, 2017 at 7 pm at the Los Angeles Department and Water Power Office Building at 300 Mandich St.

Next annual meeting is scheduled for Monday, January 29, 2018.

XII. Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at 8:39 p.m.

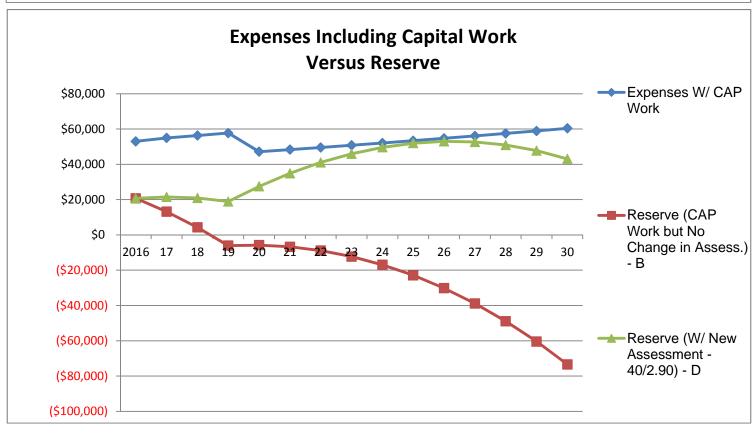

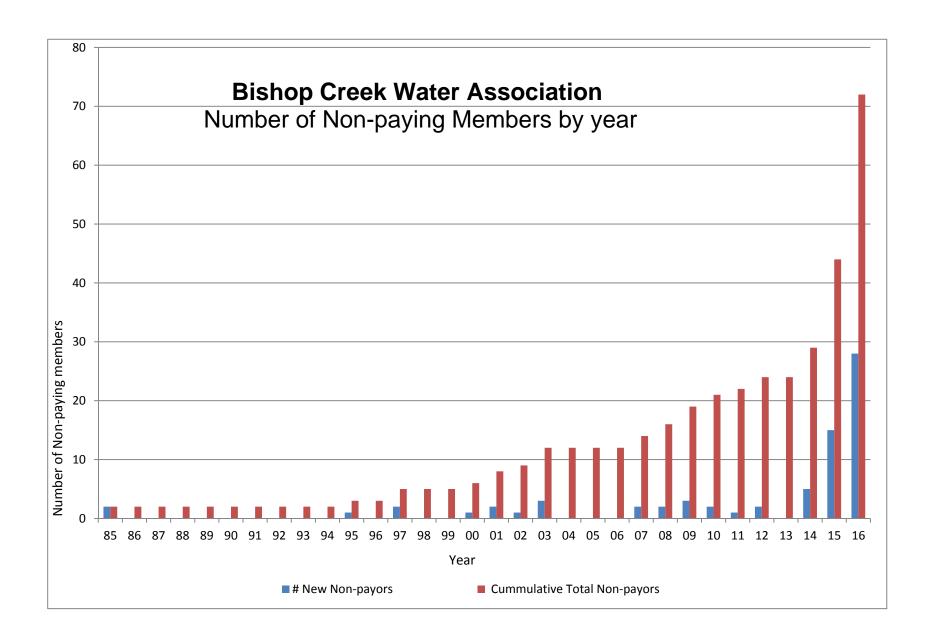
