

Bishop Creek Water Association
Monthly Meeting Summary
June 11, 2019

1. Opening and Introductions

The BCWA meeting opened at 7:00 p.m. Trustees in attendance included: Gene Coufal, Adam Perez, Henry Means, Merry Armstrong and Don Kunze. Watermaster Matt Durkee was present.

2. Acceptance of the May 14th, 2019 Monthly Meeting Summary

The May 14th, 2019 monthly meeting summary was accepted as written.

3. Approval of April and May 2019 Financial Reports

The April and May 2019 Financial Reports were reviewed and accepted.

4. Eastern Sierra Snowpack/Runoff Report

The runoff has started and creek flows are high throughout the Eastern Sierra.

5. Bishop Creek Precipitation, Flow, and Storage Report

Bishop Creek flows have been maintaining at or above the Chandler Decree requirements. Flows have been as high as 320 cfs. See attached Bishop Creek flow and precipitation charts.

6. Old Business

- a) Matlick Ditch Flow: The conditions of the conveyance system remain the same. The City of Bishop is scheduled to use its camera within the culvert section to see if there is a blockage. Matt will post a notice on the BCWA Website stating that the water will be turned off during this inspection. In the meantime, the BCWA is requesting LADWP to maximize flows down the newly cleaned section of the Tome Key Ditch to help prevent sediment build up.
- b) North/South Sunset Rd Diversion Structure Replacement: Don is investigating and will meet with the property owners to determine the best means of conveyance. Re-aligning the ditch may be preferred.
- c) Yaney Ditch Diversion Structure Repair/Replacement at:
 - i. Status is unchanged
 - ii. Status is unchanged
- d) Ditch Diversion Box Repair/Rebuild Work- Phase II: No change/nothing new to report.
- e) Collection of Past Dues: No change/nothing new to report
- f) Bishop Tribe BCWA Membership: Adam will follow up with LADWP legal department.

7. Water & Arbitration Committee Report

Nothing new to report.

8. Watermaster Report

Matt received 43 calls in May. There is nothing new to report with the Gillette Property.

9. New Business

- a) Other: Gene and Matt are set to inspect the Vista Intake (low flows on w/s of No Mountainview Rd) and the Nelligan ditch at Norberg property (obstructions in ditch). Gene also discussed sediment build up on the east end of Sunrise Dr., restricting the ability to move water in the 4X Ditch.

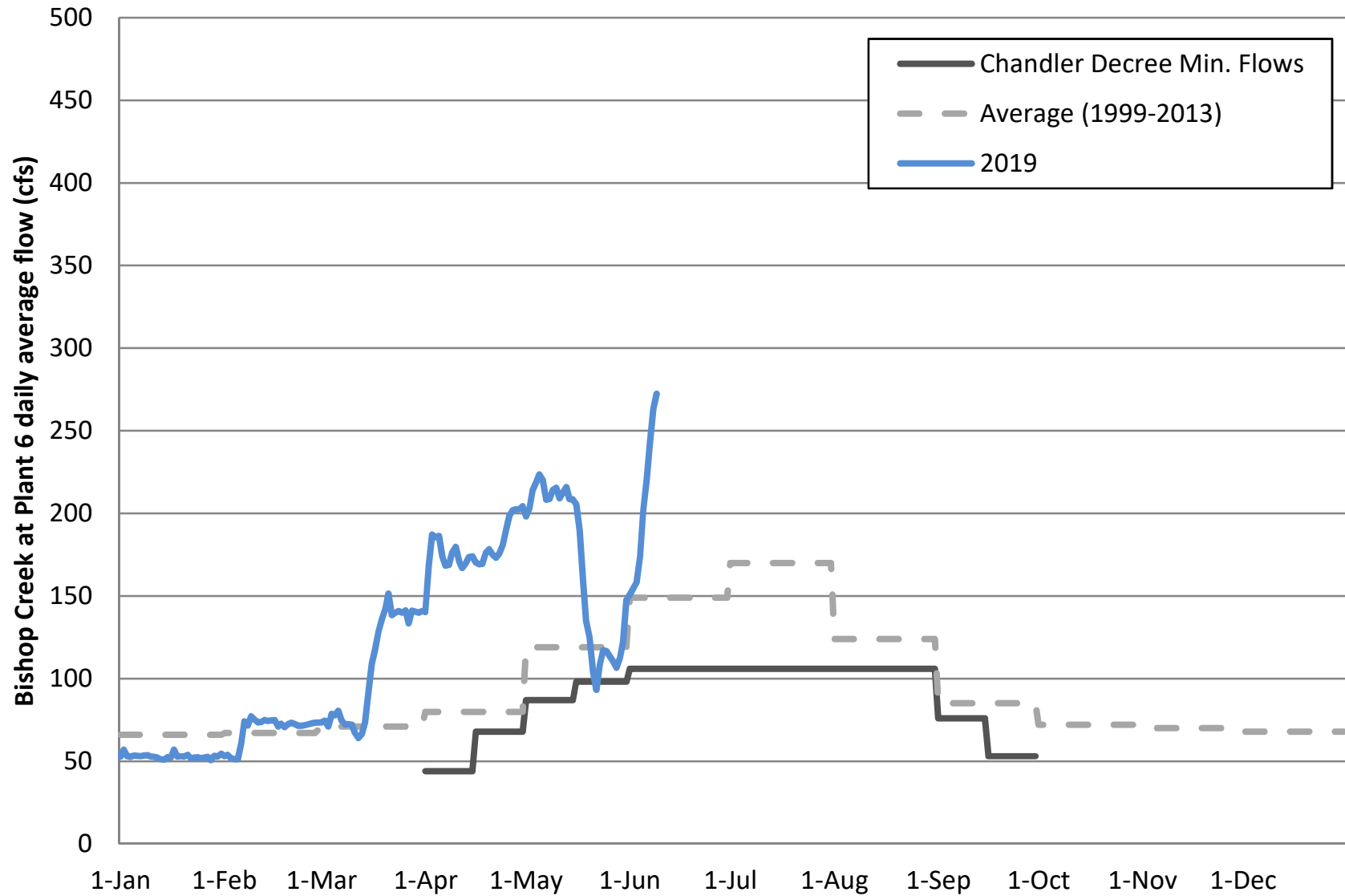

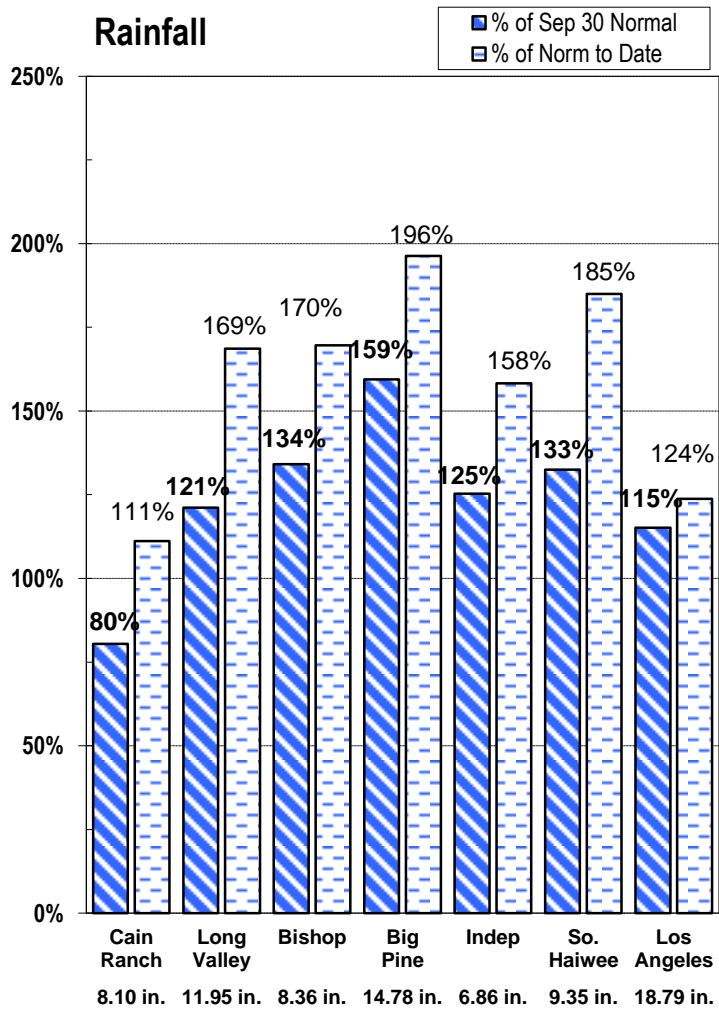
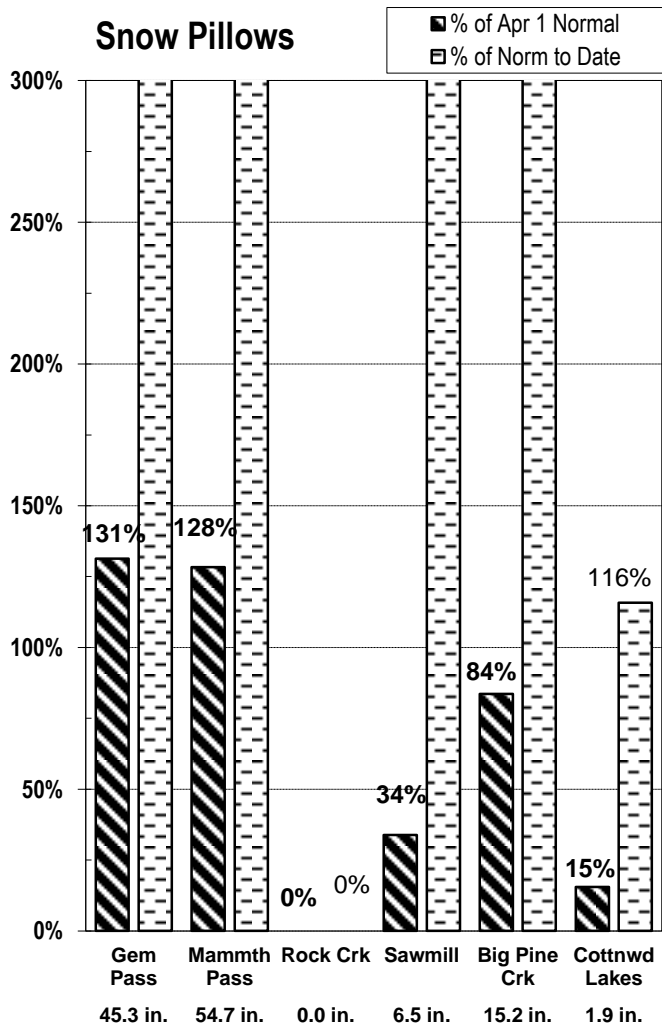
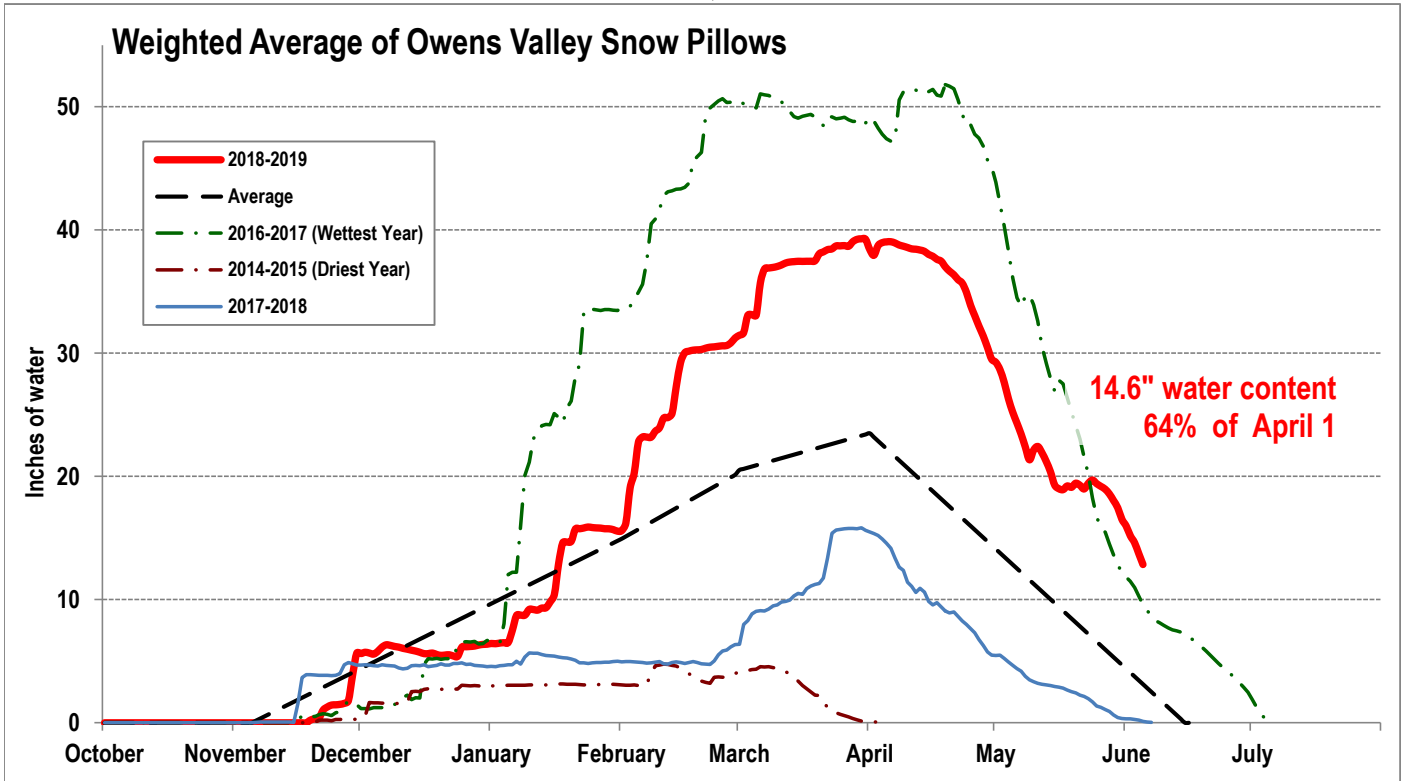
