Bishop Creek Water Association Annual Meeting Summary January 29, 2024 7:00 pm Meeting Conducted in Person and via Zoom

1. Opening and Introduction

BWCA meeting called to order 7:03 pm. Trustees in attendance: Gene Coufal, Mark Frumkin, Don Kunze, Eric Tillemans and Merry Armstrong. Watermaster Matt Durkee was present.

2. Acceptance of the Monthly Board Meeting Summary for January 9, 2024 The January 9th, 2024, meeting summary was accepted as written.

3. 2023 Annual Report

Gene provided a summary of BCWA activities during the previous year. Highlights of the summary are as follows:

- Had the usual number of issues with obstructions on member property (for specifics please see monthly board meeting summaries posted on the BCWA website, www.bishopcreekwater.org). Unfortunately, the BCWA had to get the Inyo Co sheriff involved to resolve one of the issues.
- Had to deal with 9 blocked street culverts. In the fall, a letter was sent out to all members describing the handling of street culverts by the BCWA. Thanks to the assistance of the Inyo County Supervisors representing BCWA members, discussions with Inyo County personnel regarding street culverts were initiated in December and are ongoing.
- Work on a Water Rights filing by the BCWA with the State Water Resources Control Board is progressing. And
- Mapping of BCWA ditches and membership, and reconciliation of the BCWA database is essential complete and should be used for membership assessment billing in 2024.

Randy Short spoke to the lack of a current solution to the culvert issue without the counties help. Mark Heckman continued by saying that the county received funds to build roads along with the culverts.

4. Snowpack, Precipitation and Bishop Creek Flow and Storage Report

Eric reported that the 2023 runoff is very close to the 1969 runoff, and that the snowpack for 2023-24 is off to a very slow start at about 29% of normal, which is okay because the reservoir system is still very full and LADWP cannot handle another large runoff without having to spread and release excess water.

5. 2023 Financial Report

Mark presented the financial report for 2023.

6. Approval of 2024 Budget

The 2024 Budget was approved by the majority of the members present. Randy Short motioned to approve the 2024 Budget. Holly Alpert seconded the motion and there were 18 total yes votes to approve, with 4 abstaining.

7. Election of Trustees (terms of Merry Armstrong and Mark Frumkin have expired) Merry and Mark were both elected for a new term, both received 18 yes votes with 4 abstaining.

8. New Business

a. Jerry Core offered that Inyo/Mono Title Company is willing to provide notification on new property purchases on BCWA obligations. Gene indicated that the BCWA will be providing Inyo/Mono Title Co with a set of the new maps when completed.

9. Next Meetings

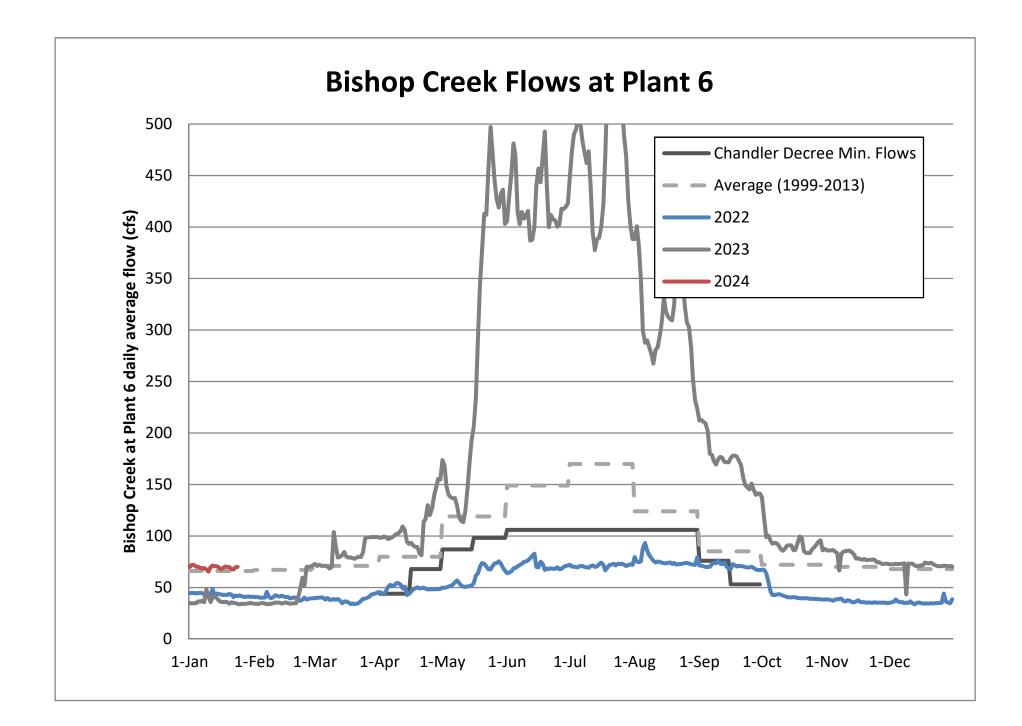

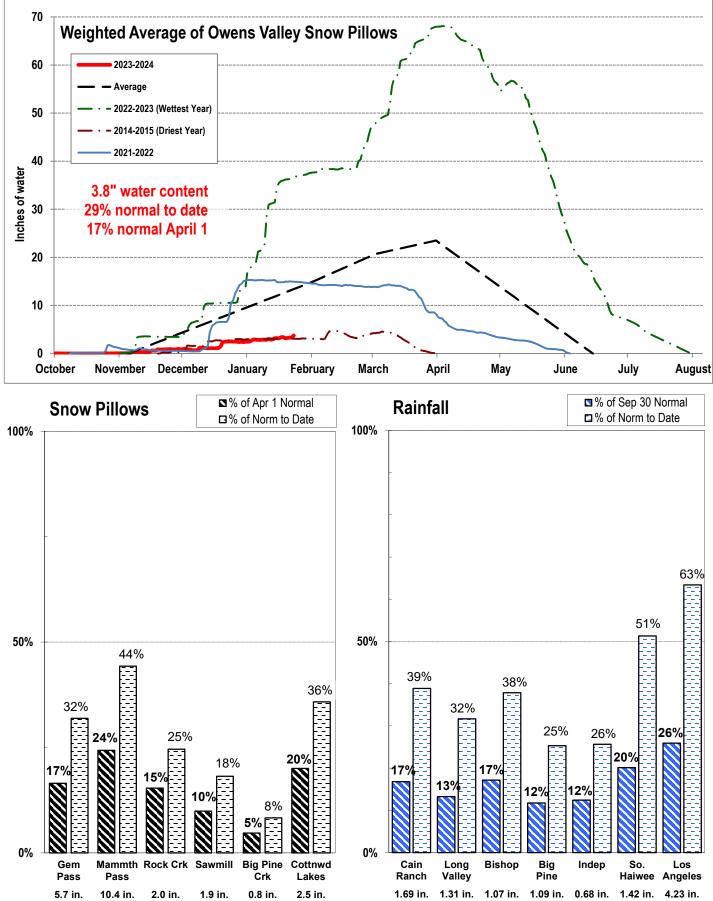

Subject: Plugged Culvert at 210 So. Mountain View Road

Dear Mr. Terry O'Brien,

It has recently been brought to the BCWA Board's attention that the culvert in front of your property is plugged again, impeding the distribution of flow. Recognizing the requirements of the BCWA Articles and By-laws, previously provided to you, this situation must be rectified. As you were previously informed, the BCWA Articles and By-Laws provide that:

"Each member shall keep his ditches free and clear of debris (sand, silt, rocks, grass, weeds, and trash) so that water, including waste water, may move for the beneficial use of members below." (Article IX, Section 4). And

"In the event the equitable distribution of water is impeded or interfered with causing flooding, wastage or other detriment to the flow of water of water to occur by reason of the refusal, inability or neglect of any member or members to remedy the same, the association may, after due notice, have the remedial work performed and the responsible member or members shall be billed therefor, at the cost of the work. "(Article IX, Section 5).

According to our letter agreement, dated December 9, 2020 (attached), to keep leaves and debris from entering the culvert in front of your property at 210 So. Mountain View Rd. you agreed to "install a grate, with 1-inch maximum opening between bars, at the culvert inlet. You will secure the grate so that it cannot be removed or tampered with by anyone other than the BCWA Watermaster. You will be responsible for the maintenance and any repair or replacement of the grate." The BCWA Watermaster reports that the grate at the inlet of the culvert has been removed.

Currently, ditch flow is being restricted at your property so that upstream and downstream BCWA members are not receiving an equitable distribution of Bishop Creek water. It is important that this situation be resolved quickly. As the owner of the subject property, it is your responsibility to maintain a clean clear ditch to convey water, and if it is not done the BCWA will be required to have the work completed and bill you for it.

The Board wants to know your intentions. To avoid any further action, we request that at a minimum we receive a communication from you on the plan to correct the problem by February 23, 2024.
